Legislative Task Force: ! Ron Reported on, and handed out information about, the CCHE statewide quality indicators that apply directly to career centers at public institutions. Ralph McNerney discussed survey methodologies for collecting and reporting graduate and employer satisfaction. The quality indicators serve as a general guideline for the minimum that has to be collected and reported by state institutions.

Workforce Training: David reminded the association that workforce training dollars are no longer available through CCHE.

School to Career: Ron reported that SB22, concerning a state income tax credit for employees establishing school to career programs, died in the appropriations committee.

CASPA: David reported that CASPA does not see any need for CCSA presense.

CCSA and Co-op Consortium: Discussion about inviting either a representative, or all members, of the Co-op Consortium to the next meeting.
